

Vacancy – Performance Manager for Welsh Bowls Extension of Closing Date for Applications

Due to the scale of events at this present time, it has been decided to extend the closing date for the post of Performance Manager. The revised timescale has been included in the advertisement below.

Previous applicants need not re-apply as their applications will be considered at this time.

The Welsh Bowls Federation (WBF) is looking to appoint a Performance Manager who will work in conjunction with the Performance Group on implementing a Performance Plan.

It is envisaged that the person appointed will possess a sound and current knowledge of elite bowls coupled with the ability to develop and improve further the performance of the most talented Elite Bowlers in Wales.

The successful candidate will have the opportunity to develop the Performance Plan and Elite Performance Programme utilising support services from the Welsh Bowls Coaching Association and National Team Managers.

This is a part time post which is, on average 3 days a week, however the hours associated with the post will be variable dependent upon the schedule of events within the Performance Plan and Elite Performance Programme variations to this, especially during busy competition periods. The salary for the post is £17,000 per annum, subject to annual review and future funding.

The appointment would commence on or around 1st October 2016 or agreeable date.
